DWS Artist Member Signature-Level Process – Deadline April 6th

Frequency: Jury process occurs in October and in April each year.

Eligibility: Associate members and nonmembers are eligible to apply for Artist member status in the Delaware Watercolor Society.

Number of Applicants: There is no limit on number of applicants who may participate in each jury session. There is no limit on the number of applicants who may be accepted during each jury session.

Benefits: Artist member signature status denotes consistent high-quality, professional-level work. This caliber of work gives the Artist member the right to sign the DWS initials after his/her name on paintings. In addition, signature status includes entry into events restricted to Artist members only.

If you want to apply for status as a signature-level Artist member, you need to get your application in soon. Applications must be postmarked by April 6. The jury process is on April 21. Please see the website homepage for more information, or contact Elizabeth Collard at (302) 645-4821.

Plein Air Arts Festival – May 6th

The Dover Days Festival will host its first ever "Plein Air Paint Out" on Sunday, May 6 on The Green and in Dover's historic district, with \$500 in cash prizes, open to all artists 18 years and age and older.
